The Japanese Grant Aid for Human Resource Development Scholarship (JDS) Project for Japanese Academic Year 2021-2023 invites applicants for 2-year Master Degree program and 3-year Doctorate Degree program.

The program aims to support human resources development of your officials, who are expected to be leaders of the country, and to engage in formulating and implementing social and economic development policies after returned. Framework consists of a single program that is designed to have twenty (20) fellows to undertake the master's degree program while two (2) fellows will be dispatched to take doctoral degree programs in Japanese Universities.

The deadline for submission of candidate's nomination is on **10 February 2021** for Master's Degree and Doctorate Degree applicants, with the following reminders:
