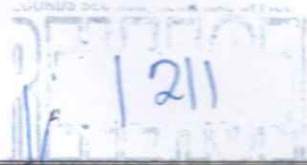

The Competition aims to promote academic excellence in Science and Mathematics; likewise create camaraderie and sportsmanship among students, pupils and coaches.

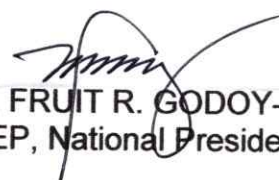

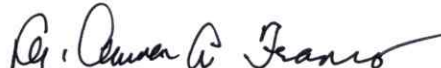

The Association of Science Educators in the Philippines (ASEP) will conduct the 19TH NATIONAL SCIENCE QUEST on March 17-19, 2023 through On-line Competition.

The schedules of different competition in the different levels are as follows:

National Level - March 17-19, 2023

The competition aims to promote academic excellence in Science and Mathematics, likewise create camaraderie and sportsmanship among students, pupils and coaches.

SCIENCE FAIR, ACTION RESEARCH, ROBOTICS TECHNOLOGY, SUMOBOT AND SPOTLIGHT COMPETITION	- First to Fifth Place School/Division/Regional winners (Individual/Team category) for Applied and Life for Elementary Level while First and Second Place Division/Regional winners from Secondary Level and Senior High School (Individual and Team Category: Cluster 1 and 2) both Public and Private Schools. - Kiddie Science Fair for NKP, Grade I and Grade II (First to Fifth Place winner in the school category).

Winners, Coaches, Advisers, Regional and Division Supervisors, ASDS, SDS, Chiefs, Assistant Chiefs, School Heads, College President, University President, Facilitators, District Supervisors, Principals, winners and other Science enthusiast are advised to participate in this activity.

Each participant shall be charged with registration fees of One Thousand Two Hundred pesos (Php 1,200.00) to cover expenses for honoraria of judges, certificates, medals, trophies, Internet Connections & Computers and other miscellaneous expenses, chargeable against Local Fund, Local School Board Fund (LSBF), Local Government Unit (LGU), Non-Government Organization (NGO) and sponsors.

GUIDELINES FOR THE SCIENCE FAIR, ACTION RESEARCH, ON-THE-SPOT VIDEO EDITING AND SPOTLIGHT COMPETITION IN ALL CATEGORIES AND ALL LEVELS FOR ONLINE CONTEST

- A. The Science Fair and Action Research will be judged with the complete write-up 70% and the Video Presentation of the Abstract it will be 30% (Send thru LBC the write-up and the USB of the Video Presentation)
- B. Spotlight contest will be judged through Video Presentation for the whole project accompanied by their write-up (Send thru LBC)
- C. The Spot Video Editing will be judge thru pictures and USB of the video presentation (Sent thru LBC)
- D. The same criteria's from the National Science Quest will be used by the judges

GUIDELINES FOR SCIENCE QUIZ, MATHE QUIZ, SPELLING BEE, ENVIRONMENTAL QUIZ, MATH HISTORY, SCIENCE HISTORY AND SCI—SCRIPTURE QUIZ FOR THE ONLINE COMPETITION.

- A. All participants in the quizzes will join in on-line competition.
- B. Be sure that your internet connections are with good quality to avoid problems during the contest.
- C. No more breaking of tie, instead if there are more than one contestant who obtain the same highest score, they will be declared First Places. The same with Second Places, Third Places, Fourth Places and Fifth Places.
- D. The same criteria from the National Science Quest will be used by the judges with regard to the points.

GUIDELINES FOR GROUP COMPETITIONS

- A. All Group Contest such as Robotics Dance, Sci-Folk Dance, Sci-Modern Dance, Sci-Cheer Dance, Jingle Making, Tugsayawit, Sci-Speech Choir, Mixrap Competition, Drum and Lyre, Sci-Creative Modeling will be judge through video presentation with the write-up if necessary.
- B. The Video presentation will be sent to ASEP for judging via Google Drive while the USB and the write-up is through LBC.
- C. The same criteria for the National Science Quest will be used by the judges with regard to the points.

GUIDELINES FOR SCI-WRITING (ENGLISH AND FILIPINO, IMPROMPTU SPEAKING AND PHOTO JOURNALISM

- A. The Impromptu Speaking will be judged through Video presentation (Topic: Positive and Negative attributes contributed of Pandemic to the mindset of Students/Pupils). (6 minutes only) The video will be sent thru LBC
- B. The Sci-writing will be judged through their actual writing in yellow pad paper at least 500 words (English Topic: Sustainability of the livelihood of people under "New Normal"), (Filipino Topic: Pagpapanaliti ng kabuhayan ng mga tao sa ilalim ng "New Normal")
- C. Photo Journalism will be judged through the actual pictures with descriptions. The pictures will be sent thru LBC

GUIDELINES FOR ON-THE-SPOT PAINTING CONTEST, SCI-ART COLORING AND COLLAGE MAKING FOR ON-LINE COMPETITIONS

- A. These categories will be judged through sending their pictures to ASEP Messenger and the short presentation video and USB will be sent to ASEP Main Office for judging
- B. The same criteria will be used by the judges with regard to the points.

GUIDELINES FOR SCIENCE FAIR FOCUS ON ALTERNATIVE/HERBAL MEDICINE ON-LINE COMPETITION

- A. Participants are Pupils, Students, Teachers, ALS and Out of School Youth.
- B. This criteria will be judge through sending the whole write-up of 70% and the Video Presentation of 30% for a total of 100%. Please send to ASEP Facebook and ASEP Messenger. The actual write-up and video presentation will be sent thru LBC

GUIDELINES FOR SIM (Strategic Intervention Materials)

- A. This category will be judge through sending of complete write-up 50% and product of the SIM and Video Presentation 50% equivalent to 100%. Video presentation, the write-up & video presentation and actual product will be sent through LBC
- B. Same criteria will be used by the judges.

GUIDELINES FOR THE LITTLE PRINCE AND PRINCESS AND GINOO AT BINIBINING KALIKASAN FOR ON-LINE COMPETITIONS

- A. The search for G. & Bb. /Little Prince and Princess will be judged through Video Presentation, a USB containing the presentation must be sent to the ASEP Management for judging.
 - 1. Attire: Casual, School Uniform, Sports Wear and Formal Wear Presentation Video
 - 2. Talent: Will be judge through video presentation (5-7 minutes)
 - 3. Question and Answer (5 minutes). Out of three (3) questions, select one (1) and discuss it through Video Presentation
 - A. "As student/pupil how will you sustain the clean and green environment to your school during this time of pandemic"
 - B. "What are the qualities that you have to win the Title of this search? (G. & Bb. Kalikasan/Little Prince and Princess)"
 - C. "What will be your contribution to this year's NSQ theme?"
- B. Video Presentation must be clear for the quality judging of the judges.
- C. All the presentation videos must be saved in a USB and sent to the ASEP Management Office.

- E. Participants/Candidates in the search must have a 4R Photo Close-up Copy in any White attire and send it at nationalsciencequest@gmail.com (indicate the Name, Division, School, Level and Private/Public category).

GUIDELINES FOR THE SCI-MODELING COMPETITIONS

- A. The Modeling will be judged through Video Presentations and a USB must be sent to the ASEP Management Office.
- B. The Same attire will be used in On-line and Actual Competition and in Video Presentations.
- C. The Same Criteria will be used in On-line contest and Actual Competition.
- D. Individual and Group Category is accepted provided that they will meet the number of participants as required in the competition guidelines.
- E. Video Presentation must be clear for quality judging of the competition.

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR THE 19th NATIONAL QUEST FOR ON-LINE COMPETITIONS

A. How to join the National Competition

1. The School coordinator will select the participants in all categories and in all levels
2. The list of participants by categories and by level will be sent to ASEP via email for final listing of contestant.

B. Registration

1. The payments from Metro bank together with the receipt must be sent to ASEP email together with the registration form and list of participants. The original list and copy of receipt be sent to LBC thru ASEP President.
2. All participants with payments at Metrobank ASEP account and duly registered will be only be qualified for the competition, Unregistered participant who did not pay their registration will be automatically disqualified from the contest.

C. All quizzes will be conducted through Edmodo apps, kindly download Edmodo and Zoom apps at the play store for your android, apple or Personal Computer.

D. All awards for the winners will be forwarded to the Regional Supervisors and ASEP Coordinators for distributions. The Division Supervisor will be In-Charge to claim the awards from the Regional Office and they are responsible to distribute to the different districts to schools to avoid missing of the awards.

E. All winners from the division and regional level the previous years and the Intel Philippines Science Fair Winners are qualified for the National Science Quest this 19th National Science Quest 2023.
