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CONTRACT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This contract made and entered into by and between:

DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, Regional Office IX, a Government Entity existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, represented herein by **DR. RUTH L. FUENTES, CESO IV**, Regional Director, with office address at Regional Government Center, Balintawak, Pagadian City, Philippines, herein now referred to as the "**FIRST PARTY**".

-and-

AJT CONSTRUCTION, represented herein by its Proprietor **MR**. **ALLAN-DRAZUL J. TABAYAG** with office address at Sunrise Village, Tiguma, Pagadian City hereinafter referred to as the "**SECOND PARTY**".

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the FIRST PARTY is desirous that the SECOND PARTY execute "Repair, Rehabilitation and Installation Works at DepEd RO IX, Balintawak, Pagadian City (Lot 2)" (hereinafter called the "Works") and has accepted a Bid by SECOND PARTY for the execution and completion of such Works and the remedying of any defects therein in the sum of Two Hundred Fifty Nine Thousand Three Hundred Sixty Three and 65/100 Pesos (PHP 259,363.65) hereinafter called "CONTRACT PRICE", detailed as follows:

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises and of mutual covenant, terms and conditions hereinafter set forth the Parties hereto have agreed and do hereby agree that:

- 1. In this Agreement words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract referred to.
- 2. The following documents as required by the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as integral part of this Agreement, viz.:
 - a. Philippine Bidding Documents (PBDs);
 - i. General and Special Conditions of Contract;
 - ii. Drawings/Plans;
 - iii. Specifications;
 - iv. Bill of Quantities; and

 SECOND PARTY's bid, including the Eligibility requirements, Technical and Financial Proposals, and all other documents or statements submitted;

c. Performance Security;

d. Notice of Award of Contract; and the **SECOND PARTY**'s conforme thereto; and

e. Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Procuring Entity concerned in the PBDs. **SECOND PARTY** agrees that additional contract documents or information prescribed by the GPPB that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed, Variation Orders, and Warranty Security, shall likewise form part of the Contract.

3. SECOND PARTY shall perform the Works contemplated in this Contract to commence within one (1) calendar day upon receipt of the Notice to Proceed or from the date as may be indicated in the Notice to Proceed. The Works shall cover the materials, equipment, tools, labor and supervision and all other items necessary to properly complete the work as indicated in the Program of Works and Bill of Quantities.

4. The **Works** shall be completed at DepEd RO-9, President Corazon C. Aquino Regional Government Center, Balintawak, Pagadian City. Violation of this provision, based on documents and reports submitted and validated by the authorized receiving personnel may be cause for the termination of the Contract.

5. The **Works**, including all materials and equipment used, under this Contract should conform to and comply with the standards mentioned in the Section VI. Terms of reference and scope of requirement. Drawings, and Bill of Quantities of the Bidding Documents, which are hereto attached as Annex "B" and made an integral part hereof.

6. In case **SECOND PARTY** encounters condition(s) delaying completion of Works, **SECOND PARTY** shall promptly notify **FIRST PARTY** in writing within five (5) calendar days from notice of such condition(s), and any request for work suspension and/or contract completion period extension shall be promptly done in writing as soon as circumstances for such requests have become apparent. SECOND PARTY must provide sufficient proof to support any request for work suspension and/or contract completion period extension.

7. The Contract Price shall be paid to **SECOND PARTY** upon submission of the documents specified in SCC Clause 13 and 14, and other documents as may be prescribed by **FIRST PARTY** in accordance with the following disbursement procedures:

a. Advance payment not exceeding fifteen percent (15%) of the contract price, to be made in lump sum or, at the most, two (2) installments, shall be paid upon written request, and only upon the submission the submission to and acceptance by **FIRST PARTY** of an irrevocable standby letter of credit of equivalent value from a commercial bank, a bank guarantee or a surety bond callable on demand, issued by a surety or insurance company duly licensed by the Insurance Commission and confirmed by **FIRST PARTY**.

b. Progress payment shall be adjusted by deducting the amount in the recoupment of the advance payment, and additional retention money amounting to 15% and 10% of the progress billing respectively. **SECOND PARTY** may submit a request for payment together with a statement of work accomplished in the following manner:

Second Payment	25%	Upon 60% work accomplished
Final Payment	50%	Upon 100% work accomplished

The aforementioned statement of work accomplished shall be certified by the assigned authorized representative of FIRST PARTY.

- 8. In case SECOND PARTY encounters condition(s) impeding timely undertaking of the Works, SECOND PARTY shall promptly notify FIRST PARTY in writing of such condition(s) and any request for work suspension and/or contract period extension shall be promptly done in writing as soon as circumstances providing justification for such requests have become apparent. SECOND PARTY must provide sufficient proof to support any request for work suspension and/or contract delivery period extension.
- 9. Warranty against Structure Defects and Failures, except those occasioned-on force majeure, shall cover a period of **five (5) years** and shall be reckoned from the date completion of The Works.
- 10. SECOND PARTY shall be liable for liquidated damages in an amount equal one- tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the cost of the unperformed portion, for every day of delay. FIRST PARTY shall deduct the liquidated damages from any money due or which may become due to SECOND PARTY, or collect from any of the securities or warranties posted by SECOND PARTY, whichever is convenient to FIRST PARTY. Once the accumulated amount of liquidated damages reaches 10% of the Contract Price, FIRST PARTY may rescind or terminate the Contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies available under the circumstances.
- 11. The PARTIES shall make every effort to resolve amicably and by mutual consultation any and all disputes or differences arising between the PARTIES in connection with the implementation of the Contract. Should such dispute be not resolved amicably, it shall be submitted before the Construction Industry Arbitration Commission pursuant to CIAC Revised Rules of Procedure Governing Construction Arbitration, as amended by CIAC Resolution Nos. 15-2006, 16-2006, 18-2006, 19-2006,02-2007,07-2007, 13-2007, 02-2008, 11-2008, 01-2010, 04-2010, 07-2010, 08-2014, 07-2016, 06-2017, 01-2019, 05-2019, and 07-2022.
